

University of North Texas - Department of Information Science Application for Grad Track

B.S. in Information Science/ M.S. in Library Science or Information Science

The Grad Track option is a BS/MS accelerated program for undergraduate students enrolled in the Bachelor of Science in Information Science (BSIS) program. Students can take a maximum of nine (9) credit hours of library science or information science graduate courses while completing the BSIS degree. These credits will be counted towards both the BS and MS degrees.

Overview:

- BSIS Students may apply for the Grad Track option in their junior year (upon completion of at least 75 credit hours with a GPA of 3.5 or higher).
- After application approval and completion of at least 90 credit hours, students may choose to complete the Master of Science in Library Science (MSLS) or the Master of Science in Information Science (MSIS) degree program.
- For the graduate courses to be counted toward a subsequent MSIS or MSLS degree, the student must maintain a B or above for the courses. The courses for each program are pre-determined.
- The student applies to the Toulouse Graduate School within the first semester of the senior year. Once the student satisfies all coursework for the BS degree and maintains a 3.5 or higher GPA, the student will be fully admitted to the MS program.
- The student must enroll in graduate school in the long semester after completing the BS degree and should take the remaining graduate courses in the following year(s) to complete the MSIS or MSLS degree. If the student did not enroll in graduate school in the long semester after finishing their degree, those graduate course credit hours will not be counted towards the MS degree even if the student comes back for graduate school in the future.

How to apply:

- 1. Complete this application form.
- 2. Provide a copy of unofficial UNT transcripts.
- 3. Provide two (2) recommendation letters from Department of Information Science faculty members.
- 4. Submit the application form, transcripts, and recommendation letters to the College of Information Advising office via email at <u>ci-advising@unt.edu</u>.
